

Tolls / Road use charge, goods transport Netherlands

Tolls, Westerschelde Tunnel (from 1.1.07; including 19% VAT)

(6.6 km tunnel between Terneuzen in Dutch Flanders (Zeeuws Vlaanderen) and Goes in South Beveland)

Tolls may be paid cash or by American Express, Visa, Mastercard, DKV and euroShell or by the electronic payment system "t-tag".

Eurovignette

Goods transport vehicles with a total weight of 12t or more are subject to road use charges for the use of motorways and assimilated roads (E-roads) in the Netherlands, Belgium, Luxemburg, Denmark and Sweden. Certificates bought in one of these countries are valid in each of the others. Drivers who are not in possession of a valid certificate will be subject to a fine.

The road use charge is differentiated not only according to the number of axles, but also according to EURO emission standards (Euro 0, Euro I, Euro II and cleaner). The tariffs are as follows:

up to 3 axles
